### As a Player, I agree:

## As a Parent, I agree to:

- 1 Accept all decisions made by the game officials.
- 2 Demonstrate good sportsmanship at CYCC Activities.
- 3 Refrain from actions that may endanger the safety or comfort of the players, coaches, game officials or spectators.
- 4 Be a positive role model and watch the game and competition in the spirit in which it was intended: as a RECREATION sponsored activity of CYCC for the physical and social development of the players.
